Dear Mr Grace,

I am writing with regards to your letter dated 01/03/16, in which you have made a complaint against the Chief Constable of Merseyside Police. I understand that the Commissioner responded to you on 23/03/16.

Your complaint was that Chief Constable Jon Murphy was an accomplice to a case of fraud allegedly committed against you by the Department of Work and Pensions.

After careful consideration I have decided that I will not be recording a complaint against the Chief Constable, as this is an abuse of the procedures for dealing with complaints.

You have not stated any evidence of the Chief Constable's personal conduct and I cannot record a complaint against him simply because he is the head of a police force.

If you disagree with this, you have the right to appeal the decision.

As your complaint involves the Chief Constable, the right of appeal is to the IPCC. To do this, you need to contact them within 28 days of this letter. Contact details for the IPCC are:
