authorising the payment of ESA (IR) for the period as shown on the attached schedule are revised, on the grounds that they were made in ignorance of a material fact and they were in all cases more advantageous to the claimant than they would otherwise have been.

The material fact is the claimant misrepresented his circumstances from the outset of the claim, namely that he was in receipt of another income.

My revised decision is that ESA (IR) should be reduced or extinguished by taking into account income of £900 per calendar month from 1/6/11. No disregards apply.

As a consequence of this decision there has been an overpayment of ESA (IR) shown on attached schedule.

I reserve the right to decide on how ESA (IR) is affected by the claimant's wife's earnings and income from Working Tax Credits.
