Income

Background

The claimant was in receipt of Employment Support Allowance (contributory based) and (Income Related) from 1/6/11 to 1/6/12 waiting days were served.. ESA (IR) ceased when the claimant requested that his wife be removed from his claim. She was removed as of 8/10/10.

A GMS match indicated that the claimant was in receipt of an income from an Income Protection Insurance. The investigation also disclosed that his wife had worked during the period of his claim and they had been in receipt of Working Tax Credits. The customer had not declared any of this income.

Evidence considered:

- Details of Income Protection Payments from Trent Services
- EQ1 and EQ1A from Barrington Cleaning - period of work 10/6/11 to 14/10/10
- EQ1 and EQ1A from Interserve - period of work 12/5/11 to 1/10/11
- Customer claim form for ESA

Mr Grace was in receipt of Income Protection payment as follows:

- 3/6/11 - £1800 covering the period 9/3/11 to 8/5/11
- 10/6/11 - £900
- 15/7/11 - £900
- 19/8/11 - £900

£900 per calendar month until it ceased on 8/3/12.
