

The Hungarian Kennel Clubs Association's (furthermore referred to as MEOESZ) Executive Committee (furthermore referred to as Executive Committee of MEOESZ), based on MEOESZ Statutes 22/g., 27/11/m., 35/2-3. by a decree of MEOESZ 46/2020.(09.18.) establishes **MEOESZ World Committee of the Hungarian Vizsla Breeds** by laying down its Operational Regulations as below:

**MEOESZ MVV, The Hungarian Kennel Club's World

Effective as from September 18th, 2020

The MEOESZ, **The Hungarian Kennel Clubs' World Committee of the Hungarian Vizsla Breeds** (furthermore referred to as : MEOESZ MVV), is an organisation established by the Hungarian Kennel Clubs Association (furthermore referred to as : MEOESZ) Executive Committee as a permanent committee with organising and controlling role focussing on the task of preserving, breeding and promoting Hungarian vizsla breeds (shorthaired Hungarian vizsla and wire-haired Hungarian vizsla) in the domestic and international arena. The Operational Regulations of MVV in compliance with the MEOESZ Statutes 35/2-3. was established by the MEOESZ Executive Committee according to the current regulations.

I. General Provisions

1./ The MEOESZ (Magyar Ebtenyésztők Országos Egyesületeinek Szövetsége) Executive Committee headquartered in 1116 Budapest, Tétényi út 128/b-130. , in line with the MEOESZ Statutes 35/2-3, in the current General Provisions determines the organisational, personal and material conditions, organisational structures and the internal reporting system necessary for the successful operation of the MVV.

When determining the current Provisions, the MEOESZ Executive Committee took into consideration the Statutes of MEOESZ, its internal regulations as well as all the relevant rules of FCI.

2 / Declaratory provisions:

The explanation of the current regulation:

- a./ Hungarian Kennel Clubs: MEOESZ or Association
- b./ Statutes of the Hungarian Kennel Clubs Association: Asz.
- c./ World Committee of the Hungarian Vizsla Breeds: MVV
- d./ Fédération Cynologique Internationale 13 Place Albert Ier., B-6530 Thuin
Belgique: FCI
- e./ the current regulations furthermore referred to as :MVV MSz.
- f./ the MVV MSz shall be interpreted in compliance with all the other regulations of the Association and FCI, its interpretation contrary to those is prohibited.

g./ at the interpretation of the terms and expressions used in MVV MSz, the rules of the simple linguistic interpretation shall govern, i.e. those words and expressions shall be interpreted according to their approved general meaning in the Hungarian language.

h./ where the current provision refers to the rules and regulations of the FCI or MEOESZ, there the prevailing effective text of the regulation shall be understood.

3. / If any regulation of MVV MSz includes a provision contradictory to the Association Asz, that shall be replaced by the regulation of the Asz. The current regulation mustn't be contradictory to any other regulation pertaining to the current regulations of MEOESZ.

The effect of the current regulation covers the Association, its members and officials (executives and others), organs, bodies, committees, other units and employees named by Asz. as well as legal entities having contractual or other legal relationship with the Association to the extent as codes of conduct are determined for them.

4. / The MVV technical committee, its members, honorary members and officials, supporters are not members of the Association as private individuals.

5. / The MVV itself is not a legal entity, it shall not obtain any rights or obligations on its own behalf and to its own advantage, it shall not make any legal declarations in the name of the Association, however, according to the definition in MVV MSz, it can proceed in functions belonging to its scope and competence within the duties carried out in the Association via the organs and officials.

The operational conditions, costs and administrative support for the MVV and its organs and officials are secured by the Association based on the stipulations in MVV MSz and based on the Association's own ad prevailing internal rules. The fees for the services and activities provided by MVV are included in the tariff schedule of MEOESZ, which is periodically determined by the MEOESZ Board so, that the MVV recommendations are also taken into consideration. The financial coverage for the activities and operation of the MVV is provided from the fees of the services and other activities of the MVV and, by third party payments and subsidies earmarked to finance the MVV activities, so all the direct and indirect costs of the MVV's activities are covered by these revenues. For that very reason, the MEOESZ keeps the record of the generated revenues by and for the MVV, separately from the direct and indirect costs of the activities of MVV. The records are communicated to the MVV Committee simultaneously at the time of the approval of the Annual Report of MEOESZ via its president or a proxy delegated by the president. The president of the MVV Committee may request information about the data in the records.

6./

Aims and duties of MVV :

- The primary aim of the MVV is to preserve and elevate the reputation of the Hungarian vizsla breeds, also as part of Hungaricums, promote the breeds in the world, and act as the most decisive organisation of the breeds

- The MVV shall oversee and coordinate the activity of the MEOESZ member breed organisations and kennel organisations in Hungary for Hungarian vizsla breeds influencing breeding, promoting and undertaking scientific research work with regard to the breeds, while emphasizing that the Hungarian vizsla breeds are hunting dogs, and preserving the Hungarian vizsla breeds for hunting purposes is a key task.
- The MVV coordinates the activity influencing the goal to preserve Hungarian vizsla for hunting purposes, breeding, promoting and undertaking scientific research work with regard to the breed conducted by overseas organizations, breed carers and kennel organisations, operating as international FCI members or FCI contract partners or, national kennel clubs as members of FCI or FCI contract partners.
- The MVV coordinates the work of Hungarian and international breeders of the Hungarian vizsla breed with a pedigree certificate recognized by FCI undertaken in order to support and positively influence the preservation of Hungarian vizsla breeds for hunting purposes and the scientific research work related to the breed and pursued with the aim to breeding and promoting the breed.
- The MVV coordinates the work of Hungarian and international breeders of the Hungarian vizsla breeds with a pedigree certificate recognized by FCI, operating as FCI members or FCI contract partners or, as breed clubs and breeding organisations as members of national kennel clubs, breeding organisations, the local breed associations of MEOESZ that work as FCI members or FCI contract partners, and supports these with events, publications and other fora.
- The MVV biannually organizes or determines the location of the World Championships including the performance and beauty shows for the Hungarian vizsla breeds and their organisations and as a part of it, the World Conference, which in its contents and the level of organizations reflects the endeavour to preserve the Hungarian vizsla breeds for hunting purposes and the goals to breed, preserve and promote the breeds, and to this end the level of the world championships and the themes of the conference shall be matching, the technical level shall be also suitable where the speakers and participants can share the available relevant professional, scientific and practical information with regard to the breeds.
- The MVV biannually publishes a publication in a book format , including the long term processing of the knowledge about the history, the breed characteristics and the available professional, scientific and practical knowledge of the Hungarian vizsla and the relevant facts about the CACIB or CACIT titles gained at FCI events, the continuous presentation of the successful individual dogs, as well as the knowledge and the information generated as a result of the activity of the MVV.
- The task of the MVV is to work out and update the criteria on the international level determining the standardized beauty, working and health related assessment and judgement based on the prevailing valid FCI standard for the Hungarian vizsla breeds.
- The task of the MVV is to make internationally known in the widest possible circle the field of activities initiated from Hungary in the area of genetic research and gene conservation and support the quality breeding of the vizsla breeds abroad by disseminating and making available these results.
- The task of the MVV is to work out recommendations for the standardized criteria and rules with regard to the behavioural and skills tests based on domestic and international experience of the Hungarian vizsla breeds and forward it to the international breeders, taking into consideration the regulations outlined by the Hungarian breed caring organisations and the MEOESZ Hunting Dog Performance Judges Body and approved by the MEOESZ Executive Committee, with special regard to the Collection of Competition and Exam Regulations for Hunting Dogs.
- The task of the MVV is to work out competition regulations on the highest level in the field of dog sports for presenting and utilizing the skills and capabilities of the Hungarian vizsla breeds and introduce these to the local and international community with the objective to showcasing and promoting the capabilities of the breeds and thus supporting their preservation.

- The task of the MVV is to establish and run dog show groups in order to gain popularity for the Hungarian vizsla breeds, so that the programs, set decorations and attires of these shows should focus on emphasizing the historic roots of the breeds.
- The task of the MVV is to work out internationally acceptable competition regulations and instinct trial system for the Hungarian vizsla breeds based on the competition regulations approved and proven suitable in Hungary and to conduct these instinct trials in the framework of the biannually organized MVV World Championships for the Hungarian vizsla breeds.
- cooperating with other MEOESZ committees and sports committees in the activities relevant for Hungarian vizsla breeds,
- participating in the management of the keeping and competition of Hungarian vizsla breeds in a civilized and animal centred manner,
- keeping track of the enforcement of the local animal protection laws in the course of the breeding, keeping and competition of the Hungarian vizsla breeds

7./ The structure of MEOESZ – MVV

• President –

The President is appointed by the MEOESZ Executive Committee by the proposal of the MVV, and the President of MEOESZ delegates him/her to fulfil the assignment; the appointment and the delegation can be withdrawn any time, the MVV can make a proposal for that. The President himself /herself impersonates the organisation of the MVV. The President shall also act as a member of the MVV. The MEOESZ Executive Committee simultaneously with the approval of the current resolution has appointed Dr. Zoltán Kovács to be the first President of the MVV, who is delegated for this assignment by the President of MEOESZ.

General Secretary

The General Secretary is appointed by the MEOESZ Executive Committee by the proposal of the President of the MVV, and the President of the MEOESZ delegates him/her from among the MEOESZ MVVs' MEOESZ member organizations' presidents to fulfil the assignment; the appointment and the delegation can be withdrawn at any time, the MVV can make a proposal for that. The duty of the Secretary is to carry out the operational activities, to represent MVV vis- a-vis to the MEOESZ and its members, and he/she undertakes the operational activities by the ad-hoc assignment of the President of the MEOESZ acting as his /her representative. The secretary shall act as a member of the MVV. The MEOESZ Executive Committee simultaneously with the approval of the current resolution has appointed Katalin Noveczki to be the first Secretary of the MVV, who is delegated for this assignment by the President of the MEOESZ.

• MVV –Executive Committee

It is made up by the presidents of those MEOESZ member organizations that with regard to the Hungarian vizsla and wire-haired Hungarian vizsla breeds are the members of MEOESZ through the breeds organizations section, 1 member for each association respectively, who are the presidents of the delegating organisations respectively, and who were appointed by the President of the MEOESZ to be the MVV members, as well as by the President and by the General Secretary of MVV. The assignment can be withdrawn at any time and will be automatically terminated once the function of the president is defunct in his/her respective organisation. The member of the MVV according to the above is the president of the MVV, the president of the Committee of Cynology of the Hungarian Chamber of Hunting and the president of the Association of Hungarian Game Breeders.

The member, associations and other members of the MEOESZ represented by the president and the members of the MVV, based on their membership thereof are entitled to receive one copy each out of the publications, annual books and other printed leaflets and brochures published by MVV, and to participate at technical conferences, information events, other meetings and world championships free of charge, represented

by one person each.

Members are obliged to make their status visible with regard to the Hungarian vizsla breeds and to live up to the name with their appearance by referring to their membership as the Member of the Hungarian Kennel Club's World Committee of the Hungarian Vizsla Breeds and by using the MVV logo.

The Secretary Responsible for Foreign Relations shall participate at the session of the MVV Executive Committee with a right to speak.

The detailed rules of operation for the MVV Executive Committee shall be established by the MVV itself.

- Body Responsible for International Relations

This Body assists the work of the MVV Executive Committee as a consultation and commenting body. Its members are invited to the Body by the MVV Executive Committee as the representatives of international Hungarian vizsla breeds overseas breeds organizations, breed carers and breeding organizations with international domicile working as FCI members or FCI contract partners or members of national kennel clubs working as FCI members or FCI contract partners which are engaged in activities with the objective to preserve Hungarian vizsla breeds for hunting purposes and /or to breed , and or/ to promote or carry out scientific research work influencing activities related to the breeds.

The task of the Body is to facilitate and support the efficiency of the MVV Executive Committee to make sure that the MVV Executive Committee can get familiar with the international opinions and results with regard to the Hungarian vizsla breeds in an institutionalized form so that they could apply these in their work. A high priority of the Body is to introduce to the stakeholders abroad with the help of the members of the Body the contents of those elaborated directives, rules, breeding and instructions of use for the international breeding and keeping of the Hungarian vizsla breeds, that have been approved by the MVV Executive Committee.

The operational work of the Body is managed by the Secretary for International Relations, who is also the member of the Body and who is delegated for this position by the President of the MVV for a definite or indefinite period of time, an assignment that can be terminated at any time by the President of the MVV without offering an explanation.

The Secretary for International Relations participates at the MVV Executive Committee meetings with the right of consultation.

The detailed rules of operation for the Body Responsible for International Relations is established by the MVV Executive Committee itself.

- Supporting organizations

Those foreign breeds associations involved in Hungarian vizsla breeds having a membership in a kennel club, which according to the domicile is either an FCI member or an FCI contract partner who wish to do so, can be the MVV supporting organizations for just one single year, which is the current calendar year, once they paid the annual supporting fee recommended by MVV and determined by MEOESZ Executive Committee , and based on the recommendation of the MVV body and the preliminary approval of MEOESZ Board, that the President of MEOESZ conferred the title on.

This status of a supporting organisation gives the power to the organisation involved to represent itself via its president at the meetings of the MVV with a right of consultation, however, it cannot vote. Furthermore, based on their memberships these organisations are entitled to receive one copy each of the publications, annual books and other printed leaflets and brochures published by MVV, and to participate at technical conferences, information events, and world championships organized by MVV free of charge, represented by one person each.

The supporting members are obliged to make their status visible with regard to the Hungarian vizsla breeds and to live up to the name with their appearance by referring to their membership as the Supporter Civil Organization of the Hungarian Kennel Club's

World Committee of the Hungarian Vizsla Breeds” and by using the MVV logo.

Other supporters

All other legal or natural entities wishing to do so, can be the MVV supporting organizations for just one single year, which is the current calendar year, once they paid the annual supporting fee recommended by MVV and determined by the MEOESZ Board. This supporting status doesn't mean membership in the MVV and the MEOESZ, and the supporter is not entitled to participate at the MVV meetings, however, these entities based on their status are entitled to receive one copy each of the publications, annual books and other printed leaflets and brochures published by the MVV, and to participate at technical conferences, information events, and world championships organized by the MVV by paying the fee specially determined for them. Such supporting members are not allowed to refer to their status in their appearances, nor are they allowed to use the MVV logo.

With the approval of the MEOESZ Executive Committee such legal entities with local domicile can become other supporters of the MVV for an indefinite period of time, they don't pay a supporting fee, but wish and are able to support the goals, professional work and other operational activities of the MVV with their other activities. By forwarding a MOU for becoming a supporting member to the MEOESZ Executive Committee through its President and, based on the approving resolution thereof, the entity shall become a supporting member on the day of the approval of the statement.

8. / The relationship of the MEOE – MVV with other bodies, committees and associations

- The MVV, its secretary and members are obliged to provide all information about their activities to the MEOESZ General Assembly, the President and the Executive Committee once a year, till March 30th of the current year, about the work done in the previous calendar year, through the MVV Secretary in a report written to MEOESZ Executive Committee.
 - They are obliged to respect all the rules of the MEOESZ with regard to their activities
 - they are obliged to cooperate in a constructive manner with other Hungarian breeds organizations that are the members of the MEOESZ and with the sports committees of the MEOESZ.

9./ The tasks of the MVV President

- to cooperate and manage the work of the MVV,
- to represent the MVV on every fora.

The tasks of the Secretary of the MVV

- To prepare a report on the work of the Committee for the MEOESZ Executive Committee
 - to realize the tasks of the MVV between its two sessions in an operational manner.
 - to represent the MVV during its operational activities based on the ad-hoc assignment by the President
 -

10./ The tasks of the MVV done as a body

- With its work as a body , by convening sessions regularly, the MVV realizes the goals and objectives as described in these regulations.
- The MVV is operated under the management of the MVV President.
- To make decisions about issues that fall within the competence of the MVV ;
- To keep documents related to the operation of the organization that are not retained by the MEOESZ Secretariat ;

11./ Liaison and representation

- The MVV in every case is represented by its President or Secretary in fulfilling the tasks of the MVV in line with the MVV MSz. The representative in his/her appearances shall make it clear that he/she will act on behalf of the MVV as a Committee of the MEOESZ and he/she is not the independent representative of the MEOESZ.
- It is important to develop and maintain international relations.

12./ Decision making

- The bodies of the MVV shall convene sessions with a frequency as it is deemed necessary. – There is a quorum at the MVV session if more than half of the members are present. Minutes shall be taken about the session, which will be signed by the participants. The Secretary shall keep record of the decisions taken by the MVV.
- The MVV at its sessions can make decisions about issues related to its tasks within the framework of the normative rules of the MEOESZ. This right for decision shall not be contrary to the Statutes of the MEOESZ and other rules of competence in compliance with its internal regulations.
 - Decisions are made by a simple majority of votes, by open voting, in the case of a tied vote the vote of the MVV President will decide.
 - All the accounting documents and receipts generated during the operations of the MVV as well as all the related other documents (offers, contracts, delivery documents, etc.) and the official copy of the decisions by the MVV, the Secretary is obliged to hand over these immediately to the office manager of the MEOESZ.
 - The secretary is responsible for keeping other documents of the MVV.
- The decisions and their effect shall be made public by the MVV on the official website of the MEOESZ made available for this purpose.
