They are of national historical importance and the, 'live and let live' memorial is protected under the category of a B Listed building. We will write to the Community Council who are currently consulting on this planning application. We are of the view that an impact assessment is essential to evidence that these important monuments will not be at risk from the thousands of festival goers expected at the event.
