

New synonym and record of the genus *Ulota* D. Mohr (Musci, Orthotrichaceae) in moss flora of China

Ulota bellissima Besch., a species previously recorded in Sichuan and Yunnan Provinces of China, is reduced to a synonym of *U. robusta* Mitt., resulting in an extension of the distribution range from Sikkim and Bhutan to China. *Ulota perbreviseta* Dixon & Sakurai, which was recorded for Korea and Japan, is reported as new to China. A key to the Chinese species of the genus *Ulota* is also provided. Lectotypes are selected for *U. robusta* and *U. perbreviseta*.
