

Data Subject Access and the Data Protection Act

Ebernoe is a very small parish council. The parish council has no allotments, burial grounds or cemeteries for example, there are no committees or working groups in operation. There is no need, therefore, to hold or process any personal data. The only information held digitally relates to email addresses for parish councillors and other statutory/non statutory agencies. A paper copy of the register of electors is held on file.

Ebernoe Parish Council understand that it is covered by the 'exemptions' clause as defined by the Information Commissioners' Office.

This could be a scanned copy of a household bill, passport or driving licence.
