### 1 John 2:14

### 1 John 2:14 New Living Translation (NLT)

<sup>14</sup>I have written to you who are God’s children because you know the Father. *I have written to you who are mature in the faith because you know Christ, who existed from the beginning. I have written to you who are young in the faith because you are strong. God’s word lives in your hearts, and you have won your battle with the evil one.*

### 1 Thessalonians 2:13

<sup>13</sup> And we also **thank God continually** because, when you **received the word of God**, which you heard from us, **you accepted it not as a human word**, but as it actually is, the word of God, **which is indeed at work in you who believe**.

### 1 Thessalonians 2:13 New Living Translation (NLT)

<sup>13</sup> Therefore, **we never stop thanking God** that when **you received his message** from us, **you didn't think of our words as mere human ideas**. You accepted what we said as the very word of God—which, of course, it is. **And this word continues to work in you who believe**.

### 1 Peter 1:25

<sup>25</sup> but the **word of the Lord endures forever**. "And this is the **word that was preached to you**.

### 1 Peter 1:25 New Living Translation (NLT)

<sup>25</sup> But the **word of the Lord remains forever**." and **that word is the Good News that was preached to you**.

**John 10:35** <sup>35</sup> **If he called them 'gods, (in BB gods is referred to as human men not GOD) to whom the word of God came—and Scripture cannot be set aside.**

### John 10:35 New Living Translation (NLT)

<sup>35</sup> And you know that **the Scriptures cannot be altered**. **So if those people who received God's message were called 'gods,' - John 10:36 - (NLT)** <sup>36</sup> **why do you call it blasphemy** when I say, 'I am the Son of God'? After all, the Father set me apart and sent me into the world. (BB Page1491)

### Question 5 – 9 Psalm 119:1-24 (NLT)

<sup>1</sup>Joyful are people of integrity, who follow the instructions of the LORD.<sup>2</sup>Joyful are those who obey his laws and search for him with all their hearts.

<sup>3</sup>They do not compromise with evil, and they walk only in his paths.<sup>4</sup>You have charged us to keep your commandments carefully.<sup>5</sup>Oh, that my actions would consistently reflect your decrees!

<sup>6</sup>Then I will not be ashamed when I compare my life with your commands.<sup>7</sup>As I learn your righteous regulations, will thank you by living as I should!<sup>8</sup>I will obey your decrees. Please don't give up on me!

<sup>9</sup>How can a young person stay pure? By obeying your word.<sup>10</sup>I have tried hard to find you— don't let me wander from your commands.<sup>11</sup>I have hidden your word in my heart, that I might not sin against you.<sup>12</sup>I praise you, O LORD; teach me your decrees.<sup>13</sup>I have recited aloud all the regulations you have given us.

<sup>14</sup>I have rejoiced in your laws as much as in riches.<sup>15</sup>I will study your commandments and reflect on your ways.<sup>16</sup>I will delight in your decrees and not forget your word.

<sup>17</sup>Be good to your servant, that I may live and obey your word.<sup>18</sup>Open my eyes to see the wonderful truths in your instructions.<sup>19</sup>I am only a foreigner in the land. Don't hide your commands from me!<sup>20</sup>I am always overwhelmed with a desire for your regulations.

<sup>21</sup>You rebuke the arrogant; those who wander from your commands are cursed.<sup>22</sup>Don't let them scorn and insult me, for I have obeyed your laws.<sup>23</sup>Even princes sit and speak against me, but I will meditate on your decrees.<sup>24</sup>Your laws please me; they give me wise advice.
