- A lot of our thinking doesn't fit with the way Grace really works
- John 1:1 In the beginning was God...
- In seeing Jesus, we see God and all of His glory
- 1 Kings 8:12 – The speaker covers a lot of information before he can share the revelation- He talks about the history and details of the Temple.
- What piece of territory does God occupy on this earth?
 - There are Four Houses he refers to in this video
 - Primary House
 - Pattern House
 - Perfect House
 - Permanent House
- ONE thing to take away today: **God will not live in a dirty house!**
- The light of God will always overwhelm the darkness of sin
- Primary House – Adam
 - Three rooms in the Primary House
 - Body
 - Soul
 - Spirit
 - God breathed into Adams nostrils and he became a spiritual being
 - Then Adam became a living soul
 - With Adams spirit he related to God
 - The true spirit man is:
 - When our soul is right, we are happy
 - Emotional happiness changes the way you act
 - We act better when we are happy

- Adam was a house desecrated by sin when he ate the forbidden fruit in the garden of Eden.
- God moved out of Adams house (God can not live in a dirty house)
- Adam was destroyed: In the day you eat... you shall surely die.
- Death came into the human race because of Adams choice
- God destroyed his primary house – Adam died in his spirit and soul
- **Gods Pattern House –The Temple**
 - A house designed with three rooms
 - *Outer Court* – corresponds to the human body
 - *Inner Court*-corresponds to fellowship-soul
 - *Holy of Holies*-innermost part where God dwelt (our spirit)
 - It was a house that was desecrated by man (Matthew 23:38)
 - Sabbath after Sabbath, the Jewish people came to the temple to worship in a Godless Temple – God was no longer there, He had moved out because of their sin.
 - There are many prophecies about the temple being destroyed and not one stone will be left, and it was completely destroyed.
 - The Temple has not been rebuilt to this day. The Temple was:
 - Designed
 - Desolated
 - Desecrated
 - Destroyed
- **Gods Perfect House – JESUS**
 - John 2:19- Jesus tells that He will destroy this temple and 3 days He will raise it up again. He was a house designed, perfect body, soul, spirit.
 - House desecrated – became dirty for us – 1 Cor. 5:20
 - Jesus became our sin
 - Jesus became a house desolated

- Jesus hanging on the cross cries out to God, “Why have you forsaken me”?
 - God will not live in a dirty house
 - Ultimately Jesus became a house that was destroyed for us
 - Matthew -He relinquished His Spirit and died
 - Jesus was perfect
- Gods Permanent House – US
- *We are the Temple of the Holy Spirit of God*
 - Read 1 Corinthians. 6:19
 - Conclusion and Revelation for todays teaching: – God will not live in a dirty house!
 - He cannot accommodate sin
- If God can’t live in a dirty house and we are the temple of God – what is the conclusion?
- **I AM NOT DIRTY!**
 - I may do a dirty deeds, but it does not make me dirty
 - You thought what you said made you dirty, it did not
 - You walk around feeling dirty most of your life, the Word says: “Behold the Lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world, though your sins be as scarlet, they shall be made white as snow.
 - As far as the East is from the West, I will remove your sins and iniquities
 - Hebrews 10 says that our sins and lawless deeds **I will remember no more**
 - What God cleanses stays cleansed
 - We can’t change what Jesus did on the cross – Its all GRACE
 - The blood cleanses and changes us
 - Jesus came to create in us a dwelling place for God to reside in!
 - Salvation is getting God out of heaven into man
 - We are living stones in His Temple
 - Christ in us, the hope of glory

- I'm not dirty, even though I feel like it sometimes.
- **Don't listen to the accuser, Satan telling you that you are unclean**
- Knowing that you are clean, (even when you don't live it everyday or feel like it) – does this make you feel like you can just go out and sin everyday because of this grace?
