

## Session Three – Salvation/Grace Scriptures

### ACTIONS WE TAKE AND ACTIONS GOD TAKES – ACTION PACKED AND LIFE GIVING WORDS OF GOD!!

**Eph 2:1-10**- Once you **were dead** because of your disobedience and your many sins. 2 **You used to** live in sin, just like the rest of the world, obeying the devil—the commander of the powers in the unseen world. He is the spirit at work in the hearts of those who refuse to obey God. 3 All of us **used to** live that way, following the passionate desires and inclinations of our sinful nature. By our very nature **we were** subject to God's anger, just like everyone else. **What does it mean, “I was dead” because of my disobedience any many sins? What do you think it means “we were” subject to Gods anger?**

4 But God is so rich in mercy, and **he loved us** so much, 5 that even though **we were dead** because of our sins, **he gave us life** when he raised Christ from the dead. **(It is only by God's grace that you have been saved!)** 6 For **he raised us from the dead** along with Christ and **seated us with him** in the heavenly realms because **we are united** with Christ Jesus. 7 So God can point to us in all future ages as examples of the incredible wealth of his grace and kindness toward us, as shown in all **he has done for** us who are united with Christ Jesus.

8 **God saved you by his grace** when **you believed**. And **you can't take credit** for this; it is a gift from God. 9 Salvation is not a reward for the good things we have done, so **none of us can boast** about it.

**Col 3:1-17**- Since **you have been raised to new life with Christ**, set your sights on the realities of heaven, where Christ sits in the place of honor at God's right hand. 2 Think about the things of heaven, not the things of earth. 3 For **you died to this life**, and your real life is hidden with Christ in God. 4 And when Christ, who is your life, is revealed to the whole world, **you will share** in all his glory. 5 So put to death the sinful, earthly things lurking within you. Have nothing to do with sexual immorality, impurity, lust, and evil desires. Don't be greedy, for a greedy person is an idolater, worshiping the things of this world. 6 Because of these sins, the anger of God is coming. 7 **You used to do these things** when your life was still part of this world. 8 **But now is the time** to get rid of anger, rage, malicious behavior, slander, and dirty language. 9 Don't lie to each other, for **you have stripped off your old sinful nature** and all its wicked deeds. 10 **Put on your new nature**, and **be renewed** as you learn to know your Creator and become like him. 11 In this new life, it doesn't matter if you are a Jew or a Gentile, circumcised or uncircumcised, barbaric, uncivilized, slave, or free. Christ is all that matters, and **he lives in all of us**.

**How do we “put on” a new nature and be renewed? What does renewed mean?**

12 Since **God chose you** to be the holy people he loves, **you must clothe yourselves** with tenderhearted mercy, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience. 13 **Make allowance for each other's faults**, and **forgive anyone who offends you**. Remember, **the Lord forgave you**, so **you must forgive others**. 14 Above all, **clothe yourselves with love**, which binds us all together in perfect harmony. 15 And let the peace that comes from Christ rule in your hearts. For as members of one body **you are called to live in peace**. And **always be thankful**.

What does God want us to be clothed with? What does forgive mean? In verse 15, what does God want to “rule” our hearts and how do we obtain it?

16 Let the message about Christ, in all its richness, fill your lives. **Teach and counsel each other** with all the wisdom he gives. **Sing psalms and hymns** and spiritual songs to God with thankful hearts. 17 And **whatever you do or say, do it as a representative of the Lord Jesus**, giving thanks through him to God the Father. **What does God want us to do in verse 16?** (teach, counsel, sing psalms and give Thanks!!)

**Rom 5:1-11-** Therefore, since **we have been made right** in God's sight by faith, **we have peace with God** because of what Jesus Christ our Lord has done for us. 2 Because of our faith, **Christ has brought us** into this place of undeserved privilege where **we now stand**, and we confidently and **joyfully look forward** to sharing God's glory.

3 **We can rejoice**, too, when we run into problems and trials, for **we know** that they help us develop endurance. 4 And endurance develops strength of character, and character strengthens our confident hope of salvation. 5 And this hope will not lead to disappointment. For **we know how dearly God loves us**, because **he has given us the Holy Spirit** to fill our hearts with his love.

What do trials develop in us? What has God given us in verse 5?

6 When **we were utterly helpless**, **Christ came at just the right time and died for us sinners**. 7 Now, most people would not be willing to die for an upright person, though someone might perhaps be willing to die for a person who is especially good. 8 But **God showed his great love for us** by sending Christ to die for us while **we were still sinners**. 9 And since **we have been made right in God's sight** by the blood of Christ, **he will certainly save us** from God's condemnation. 10 For since our friendship with God **was restored** by the death of his Son while **we were still his enemies**, **we will certainly be saved** through the life of his Son. 11 So **now we can rejoice** in our wonderful new relationship with God because our Lord Jesus **Christ has made us friends of God**.

In Verse 11, what have we become after accepting Jesus as our Savior?

**Titus 2:9-14-** Slaves must always obey their masters and do their best to please them. They must not talk back or steal, but must show themselves to be entirely trustworthy and good. Then they will make the teaching about God our Savior attractive in every way.

What do you see this verse telling you?

11 For the grace of God has been revealed, bringing salvation to all people. 12 And **we are instructed** to turn from godless living and sinful pleasures. **We should** live in this evil world with wisdom, righteousness, and devotion to God, 13 while **we look forward with hope** to that wonderful day when the glory of our great God and Savior, Jesus Christ, will be revealed. 14 **He gave his life to free us from every kind of sin**, to cleanse us, and **to make us his very own people**, totally committed to doing good deeds.

**Rom 6:20-23-** When **you were slaves to sin, you were free from the obligation to do right**. 21 And what was the result? **You are now ashamed** of the things **you used to do**, things that end in eternal doom. 22 **But now you are free** from the power of sin and **have become** slaves of God. **Now you do** those things that lead to holiness and result in eternal life. 23 For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life through Christ Jesus our Lord.

In verse 21 we are now (?????) of what things we use to do? In verse 22..... Now (????) what?

**Rom 8:1-4-**So now there is no condemnation for those who belong to Christ Jesus. 2 And **because you belong to him**, the power of the life-giving Spirit has **freed you** from the power of sin that leads to death. 3 The law of Moses was unable to save us because of the weakness of our sinful nature. So **God did what the law could not do**. **He sent his own Son in a body like the bodies we sinners have**. And in that body God declared an end to sin's control over us by **giving his Son as a sacrifice for our sins**.

What does condemnation mean?

**2 Cor 5:14-21**

14 Either way, **Christ's love controls us**. Since **we believe** that Christ died for all, **we also believe** that we have all died to our old life. 15 **He died for everyone** so that those who receive his new life will no longer live for themselves. Instead, **they will live for Christ**, who died and was raised for them.

16 So **we have stopped evaluating others** from a human point of view. At one time **we thought** of Christ merely from a human point of view. How differently **we know him now!** 17 This means that anyone who belongs to Christ has **become a new person**. The old life is gone; a **new life has begun!**

What does verse 17 say happens to us when we get saved?

18 And all of this is a gift from God, who **brought us back to himself** through Christ. And **God has given** us this task of reconciling people to him. 19 For **God was in Christ**, reconciling the world to himself, no longer counting people's sins against them. And **he gave us** this wonderful message of reconciliation. 20 **So we are Christ's ambassadors**; God is making his appeal through us. **We speak for Christ** when we plead, "Come back to God!" **What does reconciliation mean?**

**1 Tim 1:12-16-** I thank Christ Jesus our Lord, who has **given me strength to do his work**. He considered me trustworthy and **appointed me to serve him**, 13 even though *I used to* blaspheme the name of Christ. In my insolence, I persecuted his people. But God had mercy on me because **I did it in ignorance and unbelief**. 14 Oh, how generous and gracious our Lord was! **He filled me with the faith and love that come from Christ Jesus**.

15 This is a trustworthy saying, and everyone should accept it: "**Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners**"—and I am the worst of them all.

**Rom 3:23-25-** For **everyone has sinned**; we **all fall short** of God's glorious standard. 24 Yet God, with undeserved kindness, declares that **we are righteous**. **He did this through Christ Jesus when he freed us from the penalty for our sins**. 25 For God presented Jesus as the sacrifice for sin. **People are made right with God when they believe that Jesus sacrificed his life, shedding his blood**.

**How are we “made right” with God?**

**Mark 8:34-38-** Then, calling the crowd to join his disciples, he said, "If any of you wants to be my follower, **you must turn from your selfish ways**, take up your cross, and **follow me**. 35 If **you try to hang on to your life, you will lose it**. But if you **give up your life** for my sake and for the sake of the Good News, **you will save it**. 36 And what do **you benefit** if you gain the whole world but lose your own soul? 37 Is anything worth more than your soul? 38 If anyone is ashamed of me and my message in these adulterous and sinful days, the Son of Man will be ashamed of that person when **he returns in the glory of his Father with the holy angels**."

**What do you think verse 34 is saying? Take up your cross.... What does that mean?**

**Heb 4:11-16-** So let us **do our best** to enter that rest. But if **we disobey God**, as the people of Israel did, we will fall. **How do we “enter into” Gods rest, what does this mean?**

**12** For the word of God is alive and powerful. It is sharper than the sharpest two-edged sword, cutting between soul and spirit, between joint and marrow. It exposes our innermost thoughts and desires. **13** Nothing in all creation is hidden from God. Everything is naked and exposed before his eyes, and he is the one to whom we are accountable.

**What do you think verse 12 means by the word of God being “sharper than a two edged sword?**

**In verse 15 what does God understand we have to deal with?**

14 So then, since we have a great High Priest who has entered heaven, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold firmly to what we believe. 15 This High Priest of ours understands our weaknesses, for he faced all of the same testings we do, yet **he did not sin**. 16 So **let us come boldly** to the throne of our gracious God. There **we will receive** his mercy, and **we will find grace** to help us when we need it most.

**How do we come to the throne of Grace?**

**Heb 11:1-2-** Faith is the confidence that what **we hope** for will actually happen; **it gives us** assurance about things we cannot see. **What is faith? Does it have substance? Can you see it? If you have seen faith in someone, embellish on that.**

**1 Cor 1:20-25-** So where does this leave the philosophers, the scholars, and the world's brilliant debaters? God has made the wisdom of this world look foolish. 21 Since God in his wisdom saw to it that the world would never know him through human wisdom, **he has used our foolish preaching to save those who believe.** 22 It is foolish to the Jews, who ask for signs from heaven. And it is foolish to the Greeks, who seek human wisdom. 23 So when we preach that Christ was crucified, the Jews are offended and the Gentiles say it's all nonsense.

24 But to those called by God to salvation, both Jews and Gentiles, Christ is the power of God and the wisdom of God. 25 This foolish plan of God is wiser than the wisest of human plans, and **God's weakness is stronger than the greatest of human strength.**

**Acts 2:38-40-** Peter replied, "Each of **you must repent of your sins**, turn to God, and **be baptized** in the name of Jesus Christ to show that **you have received** forgiveness for your sins. Then **you will receive** the gift of the Holy Spirit. 39 This **promise is to you**, and to your children, and even to the Gentiles—all who have been called by the Lord our God."

*God's Word tells us 3 specific things in  
all of these scriptures:*

*Ephesians 2:1-9 – Colossians 3:1-7 - Romans 5:1-11 – Titus 2:9-14 – Romans 6:23  
Romans 8:1-3 – 2 Corinthians 5:14-20 – 1 Timothy 1:12-15 – Romans 3:23 – Mark 8:34-38  
Hebrews 4:11-16 – Hebrews 11:1 – 1 Corinthians 1:20-25 – Acts 2:38-39 – Exodus 3:1-10*

- ✓ **14 times** God talks about how we “used to be” prior salvation and what we must do to about becoming like Him.
- ✓ **32 times** God talks about what He DID for us in order to receive His eternal salvation.
- ✓ **67 times** God talks about giving us Hope and Direction; showing us “how to” walk according to His will and word=we win!

To “**sum it all up**” God spends more time telling us about how much He loves us; He gives us specific instructions on how to live and become like Him and less talk about “our past”.

He is our saving Grace and Hope. Nothing we can do or say can make Him love us less and nothing we can “do or work for” can earn our salvation – it’s all Jesus and our faith and trust IN HIM!

And **God has given** us this task of reconciling people to him. 19 For **God was in Christ**, reconciling the world to himself, no longer counting people's sins against them. And **he gave us** this wonderful message of reconciliation. 20 **So we are Christ's ambassadors**; God is making his appeal through us. **We speak for Christ** when we plead, "Come back to God!"

**1 Tim 1:12-16-** I thank Christ Jesus our Lord, who has **given me strength to do his work**. He considered me trustworthy and **appointed me to serve him**, 13 even though *I used to* blaspheme the name of Christ. In my insolence, I persecuted his people. But God had mercy on me because **I did it in ignorance and unbelief**. 14 Oh, how generous and gracious our Lord was! **He filled me with the faith and love that come from Christ Jesus**.

15 This is a trustworthy saying, and everyone should accept it: "**Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners**"—and I am the worst of them all.

**Rom 3:23-25-** For **everyone has sinned**; we **all fall short** of God's glorious standard. 24 Yet God, with undeserved kindness, declares that **we are righteous**. **He did this through Christ Jesus when he freed us from the penalty for our sins**. 25 For God presented Jesus as the sacrifice for sin. **People are made right with God when they believe that Jesus sacrificed his life, shedding his blood**

**Mark 8:34-38-** Then, calling the crowd to join his disciples, he said, "If any of you wants to be my follower, **you must turn from your selfish ways**, take up your cross, and **follow me**. 35 If **you try to hang on to your life, you will lose it**. But if you **give up your life** for my sake and for the sake of the Good News, **you will save it**. 36 And what do **you benefit** if you gain the whole world but lose your own soul? 37 Is anything worth more than your soul? 38 If anyone is ashamed of me and my message in these adulterous and sinful days, the Son of Man will be ashamed of that person when **he returns in the glory of his Father with the holy angels**."

**Heb 4:11-16-** So let us do our best to enter that rest. But if we disobey God, as the people of Israel did, we will fall.

**12 For the word of God is alive and powerful. It is sharper than the sharpest two-edged sword, cutting between soul and spirit, between joint and marrow. It exposes our innermost thoughts and desires.**

**13 Nothing in all creation is hidden from God. Everything is naked and exposed before his eyes, and he is the one to whom we are accountable.**

14 So then, since we have a great High Priest who has entered heaven, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold firmly to what we believe. 15 This High Priest of ours understands our weaknesses, for he faced all of the same testings we do, yet **he did not sin**. 16 So **let us come boldly** to the throne of our gracious God. There **we will receive** his mercy, and **we will find grace** to help us when we need it most.

**Heb 11:1-2-** Faith is the confidence that what we hope for will actually happen; it gives us assurance about things we cannot see.

**1 Cor 1:20-25-** So where does this leave the philosophers, the scholars, and the world's brilliant debaters? God has made the wisdom of this world look foolish. 21 Since God in his wisdom saw to it that the world would never know him through human wisdom, **he has used our foolish preaching to save those who believe.** 22 It is foolish to the Jews, who ask for signs from heaven. And it is foolish to the Greeks, who seek human wisdom. 23 So when we preach that Christ was crucified, the Jews are offended and the Gentiles say it's all nonsense.

24 But to those called by God to salvation, both Jews and Gentiles, Christ is the power of God and the wisdom of God. 25 This foolish plan of God is wiser than the wisest of human plans, and **God's weakness is stronger than the greatest of human strength.**

**Acts 2:38-40-** Peter replied, "Each of **you must repent of your sins**, turn to God, and **be baptized** in the name of Jesus Christ to show that **you have received** forgiveness for your sins. Then **you will receive** the gift of the Holy Spirit. 39 This **promise is to you**, and to your children, and even to the Gentiles—all who have been called by the Lord our God."
