

## Hope Mountain Vaulters Code of Conduct

All vaulters and parents will be required to read and sign this acknowledgement. No vaulter will be allowed to practice until this signed acknowledgement is on file.

- **Be on time** Vaulters must be on time and prepared for each practice. Hair must be tied back. Vaulter needs to bring to practice vaulting shoes, running shoes, water bottle.
- **Give your full attention** Vaulters must be respectful of coach by listening and paying attention at all times. Talking and goofing off on the sidelines will not be tolerated, and may result in losing horse time or being excused from practice.
- **Classes are for Hope Mountain Vaulters only.** Siblings who are not signed up for class are not allowed in practice area, in the barn, in the house, on the equipment or around the horses. Any non-vaulting siblings must be chaperoned by their parent at all times.
- **Horse time is a privilege** Vaulters must honor and respect horse time. The horse works very hard doing his job. If a vaulter is not ready and prepared for his/her go on the horse he/she will lose horse time privilege.
- **Respect the lunger** The lunger has a very important role ensuring the horse is working consistently and safely for the vaulters. While standing next to the lunger vaulters must be quiet and ready for their go when the lunger cues them. Vaulter may not go out to the horse before they are signaled by the lunger. For safety purposes this will be strictly enforced.
- **Bathroom breaks** We recognize a vaulter may need to use the bathroom during practice. Vaulter needs to ask their coach to be excused and must return promptly. Hope Mountain Vaulters will be providing a porta potty near the arena once the weather warms. Group bathroom breaks will not be permitted.
- **Pick your vaulter up on time.** Out of respect to the coaches, and residence of the practice facility please pick your vaulter up on time. Hope Mountain Vaulters requires that each child be picked up promptly.
- **Do your part.** Before leaving practice vaulters are responsible for cleaning up barrel practice area, assist in caring for their horse, and sweeping barn. Check with your coach and Lunger before leaving class.
