PARTICIPATION RULES AND CONDITIONS

SPACE AVAILABLE:

- The exhibition will be held inside the Centre communautaire multifonctionnel. Each exhibitor will be allocated an area of about 10 feet x 10 feet.
- Each exhibitor is responsible to put together and take apart his or her booth. You can leave behind all your stuff for the 3 days.
- Chairs and tables of 60 inches x 30 inches will be provided on site.
- The exhibitor can bring furniture as long as it fits in the space allocated.
- Decorate your booth for the occasion. Be creative!

EXPOSED PRODUCTS:

- All works must be authentic created by the artist or craftsman.
- All reproductions will show the number of copies (eg 4/100). This is not applicable to greeting cards;
- All consumer and beauty products must be clearly identified by listing all ingredients (ex .: contains almonds, hand wash, decorative pieces etc.);
- The unframed artwork (photo, watercolor, drawing, pastel, canvas board) must be professionally presented under mat, sealed or self-sealing polybag. Regular canvas and gallery canvas must have the outline painted.
- No price limit is imposed on the value of the work presented.

REGISTRATION AND COST:

- The exhibitor must complete the registration form and send it by mail or email via artdelordinaire@hotmail.com.
- Fees must be paid in full by bank transfer via email to: artdelordinaire@hotmail.com by October 1st, 2021.
- If you pay by check, make it to the order of *Art de l'Ordinaire*. You have until October 1st 2021 to send the check at this address :

- Registration fee:
 - \$50 for the 3 days for members of the association.
 - \$90 for non-members.
 - Please add your location fees for the wire mech for \$5 each, if required.
- **All participants have to provide proof of full vaccination with que QR code as required by Public Health Center and the municipality.**
- Prior to the event, first timer artist or craftsman will go through a selection committee.
- In case of cancellation, there will be no registration fee refund, except if the activity is being canceled by the Association.

INSTALLATION:

- Exhibitors are solely responsible for their inventory.
- Exhibitors must report to set up their booth Friday, November 19th from 8:00 am to 12h30 pm at the Centre communautaire multifonctionnel.
- Exhibitors are responsible for obtaining necessary insurance cover as desired. The Centre communautaire multifonctionnel, Art de l'Ordinaire and all other organizations affiliated to the event are not responsible for any damaged, broken or stolen items.

SALE:

- Exhibitors are responsible for selling their works and providing packaging.

REMOVAL:

- Dismantling will be done at 4 pm only on November 21st 2021. No dismantling will be allowed before and space must be free no later than 7pm.

COMMITMENT AND RESPONSIBILITY:

- In the event that exhibitors should be away from their booth, they must provide a representative.
- Exhibitors undertake to leave their site to its original condition.
- Exhibitors agree to the above participation rules and conditions understanding that it may compromised their stay. No refund or compensation would then be given.
- Exhibitors accept to release Art de l'Ordinaire, partners, volunteers and sponsors from any liability in case of breakage, damage or theft in respect to his or her products or any personal achievement without prejudice, especially as there are inventory taken.
