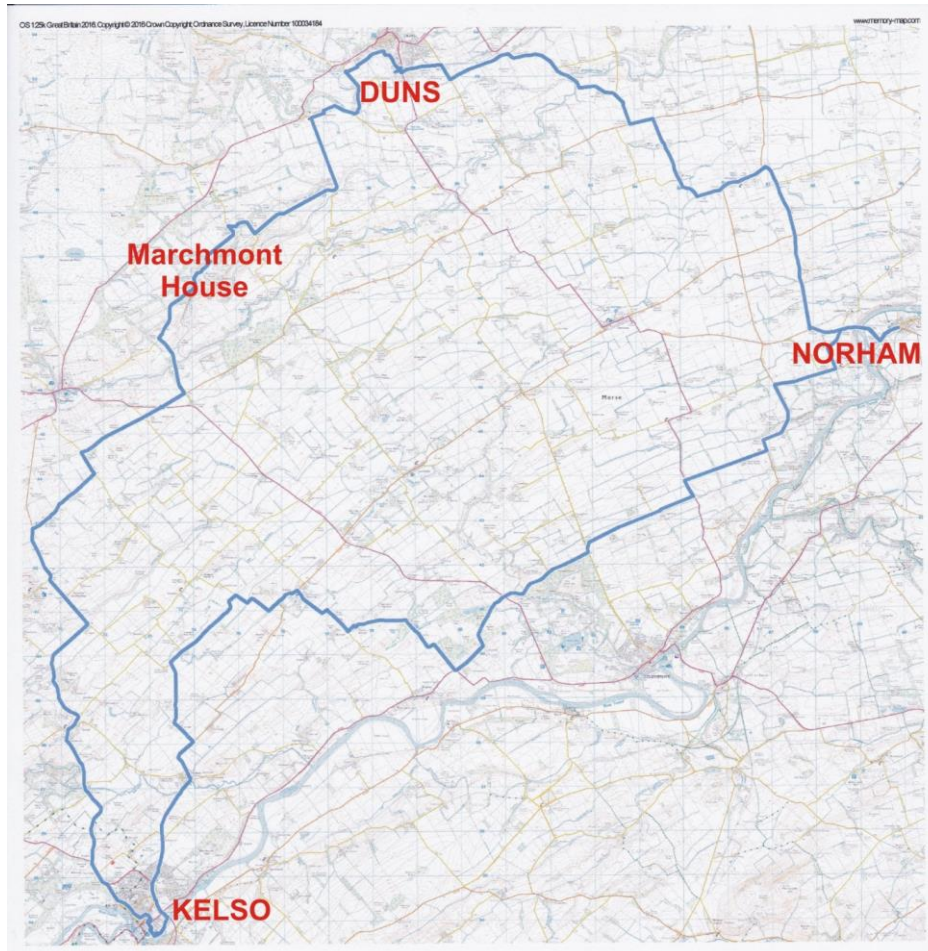


Berwick Cyclists Ride
