## Chapter Four (4) – “We have a Teacher”

### Question # 1-1 Corinthians 3:1

Brothers and sisters, I could not address you as people who **live by the Spirit** but as people who are still worldly—**mere infants** in Christ. <sup>2</sup>I gave you milk, not solid food, for you were not yet ready for it. Indeed, you are **still not ready**.

**1 Corinthians 2:15-16** - Those who are spiritual can evaluate all things, but they themselves cannot be evaluated by others. <sup>16</sup>For, “Who can know the LORD’s thoughts? Who knows enough to teach him?” **But we understand these things, for we have the mind of Christ.**

**Question # 2- 1 Peter 2:2** - Like newborn babies, **crave** pure spiritual milk, so that **by it you may grow up** in your salvation, **cry out for nourishment**.

**1 Corinthians 3:2**- I had to feed you with milk, not with solid food, because you weren't ready for anything stronger. And you still aren't ready,

**Hebrews 5:12-15** - *You have been believers so long now that you ought to be teaching others. Instead, you need someone to teach you again the basic things about God's word.* You are like babies who need milk and cannot eat solid food. <sup>13</sup> For someone who lives on milk is still an infant and doesn't know how to do what is right.

Crave= Powerful desire – Hunger and Thirst for something.

**Question # 3- Hebrews 5:12-14** - (READ PAGE 44 AND 45 OUTLOUD – HAVE THE LADIES READ IT FROM BOOK- this is commentary notes on this verse)

<sup>12</sup> In fact, though by this time you ought to be teachers, you need someone to teach you the elementary truths of God's word all over again. You need milk, not solid food! <sup>13</sup> Anyone who lives on milk, being still an infant, is not acquainted with the teaching about righteousness. <sup>14</sup> But solid food is for the mature, **who by constant use have trained themselves to distinguish good from evil** (BB Page 2247)

**Question # 5 - Jesus sends us the Holy Spirit after going to Heaven.**

**Proverbs 1:23** - Repent at my rebuke! Then I will pour out my thoughts to you, I will make known to you my teachings. Here we see the benefits available to those who will stop and listen. Amidst all of the confusion, the crowds, the bustle of activity, some will stop to listen, and accept these difficult words. These are the people who hear what wisdom says and believe. This also means turning away from the sinful temptations. To such people, wisdom will give knowledge freely. Solomon tells us that wisdom will be poured out to them. In the New Testament this concept is furthered by James when he states, "If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask God, who gives generously to all without reproach, and it will be given him." (James 1:5).

**Isaiah 11:2** - The Spirit of the LORD will rest on him (JESUS)— the Spirit of wisdom and of understanding, the Spirit of counsel and of might, the Spirit of the knowledge and fear of the LORD. (BB page 869)

**Isaiah 40:13-14** - Who can fathom the Spirit of the LORD, or instruct the LORD as his counselor?<sup>14</sup> Whom did the LORD consult to enlighten him, and who taught him the right way? Who was it that taught him knowledge, or showed him the path of understanding? NO ONE!!! (BB Page 887)

**John 14:16-17**- And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another advocate to help you and be with you forever— <sup>17</sup>the Spirit of truth. The world cannot accept him, because it neither sees him nor knows him. But you know him, for he lives with you and will be in you. (BB Page 1513)

**John 15:26** - "When the Advocate comes, whom I will send to you from the Father—the Spirit of truth who goes out from the Father—he will testify about me.

**1 Corinthians 2:9-10** - However, as it is written: "What no eye has seen, what no ear has heard, and what no human mind has conceived" the things God has prepared for those who love him<sup>10</sup> these are the things God has revealed to us by his Spirit. The Spirit searches all things, even the deep things of God. (BB Page 1757)

**1 Corinthians 2:13** - This is what we speak, not in words taught us by human wisdom but in words taught by the Spirit, explaining spiritual realities with Spirit-taught words.

**1 John 2:27** -As for you, the anointing you received from him remains in you, and you do not need anyone to teach you. But as his anointing teaches you about all things and as that anointing is real, not counterfeit—just as it has taught you, remain in him. (BB Page 2415-2416) READ THIS

**Revelation 2:29** - Whoever has ears, let them hear what the Spirit says to the churches. (BB Page 2464)

## CRAVE - HUNGER AND THIRST VERSES IN THE BIBLE - #4 Knowing Gods Word

### Psalm 78:29

The people ate their fill. He gave them what **they craved**.

### 1 Corinthians 10:6

These things happened as a warning to us, so that we would **not crave evil things** as they did,

### Galatians 5:16

[ *Living by the Spirit's Power* ] So I say, **let the Holy Spirit guide your lives**. Then you **won't** be doing what your **sinful** nature **craves**.

### 1 Peter 2:2

Like newborn babies, you must crave pure spiritual milk so that **you will grow** into a full experience of salvation. **Cry out for this nourishment**,

### Psalm 17:14

By the power of your hand, O LORD, destroy those who look to this world for their reward. **But satisfy the hunger of your treasured ones**. May their children have plenty, leaving an inheritance for their descendants.

### Psalm 105:40

They asked for meat, and he sent them quail; **he satisfied their hunger** with manna—bread from heaven.

### Psalm 145:16

When you open your hand, you **satisfy the hunger** and thirst of every living thing.

### Psalm 147:14

He sends peace across your nation and satisfies your **hunger** with the finest wheat.

### Isaiah 49:10

They will neither **hunger** nor thirst. The searing sun will not reach them anymore. For the **LORD in his mercy will lead** them; he will lead them beside cool waters.

**From Knowing Jesus Website:** Unregenerate man in his wisdom failed to know God and so the wisdom of God is hidden to those that are perishing. Certain mysteries which were revealed to Paul for the Church had been hidden from the Old Testament prophets of God from before the foundation of the world. But many truths and teachings that were given to God's people Israel are also referenced in the New Testament, It was Isaiah 64:4 about which Paul was referring to when he wrote: *but as it is written, eye has not seen and ear has not heard.. nor has it entered into the heart of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love Him and wait for Him.*

Isaiah was writing at a point in Israel's history when God's chosen nation had drifted far away from Him and many were following after false deities and engaging in pagan rituals. There was nevertheless a little remnant that were faithful to the Lord, and Isaiah encouraged them as he told them of their coming Messiah and of the many blessings that are stored up for the people of God:

There were certain things that God revealed to the prophets of old and certain revelations that God made to Paul and His New Testament apostles and prophets, but we are not party to the whole mind of God. Although certain elements of God's wisdom have already been revealed to us through holy men of God, who were moved by the supernatural work of the Spirit of God, which can be found in the writing of inerrant Scripture.. **there is much of God's infinite wisdom and knowledge that continues to remain hidden to the limited finite minds and flawed imaginations of fallen man.**

God in His grace has revealed to us that He has prepared amazing and wonderful things for those that love and trust Him. Indeed the Lord Jesus Himself said that He was going to prepare a place for us in His Father's house.. but we do not know all the wonderful things are being prepared for us, and the Bible reminds us that we cannot even imagine what they could be.. for God in His wisdom has said that eye has not seen, ear has not heard and the imagination of man is too limited to envisage what God has prepared for those that love him..
