The 8 points from Saturday have moved the 'B' team up one place to 4<sup>th</sup> in division 2, with 42 points from 7 games.

**Division 3:** Another week without a game for Ventnor 'C' resulting in a drop down to 4<sup>th</sup> position in the table.
